Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2024-133 granting the Union's petition for modification, the existing certification, set forth in PELRB Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate, Case No. S-0379 (December 12, 1995), is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by the State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, Inc., SEIU Local 1984 for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows:



**Excluded:** Director of Public Works, Deputy Director, WWTP Operations Manager, WWTP Superintendent (Chief Operator), Foreman (Sewer, Highway, Transfer Station, Vehicle Maintenance), Operations Coordinator, and Engineering Technician.

The Town of Hampton shall negotiate with the State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, Inc., SEIU Local 1984 as exclusive representative, on the terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit and shall recognize the right of the State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, Inc., SEIU Local 1984 to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
