## Order

The parties in the above-captioned matters appeared for a status conference on July 26, 2024, to discuss issues and scheduling. Case G-0109-16 is a Petition for Certification-Challenge to Existing Representative requesting a representation election for certain Department of Corrections employees currently represented by Teamsters Local 633 (Teamsters). Case G-0109-17 is an Unfair Labor Practice complaint filed by the Teamsters claiming violations of RSA 273-A:5, I (a), (b), and (c). The Teamsters allege that member(s) of a State Employees' Association of NH, SEIU Local 1984 (SEA) Department of Corrections supervisors bargaining unit and SEA employee(s) improperly solicited confidential authorization cards<sup>1</sup> from employees represented by the Teamsters. As relief, the Teamsters request a cease and desist order and the rejection of

any authorization cards signed within the confines of the secure facilities at the request of a superior officer. After extensive discussion about relevant background and how to structure these cases going forward, the parties agreed to proceed as follows:

- 1. The answer to the complaint in Case No. G-0109-17 is still due on or before July 31, 2024 (but an appearance and answer by the State is deferred per below).
- 2. The parties shall meet and confer to develop pre-election conduct ground rules and file same on or before August 15, 2024. All other applicable election ground rules shall also apply.
- 3. The PELRB will review the parties' submission and issue orders on the pending election petition with the objective of completing a pre-election conference on or before September 4, 2024.
- 4. Further docket activity in Case No. G-0109-17 is deferred pending completion of an election in Case No. G-0109-16.
- 5. Any objections to the conduct of the election shall be filed per the requirements of N.H. Admin. Rules, Pub 303.11.
- 6. Within ten days after the tally of ballots, the Teamsters shall submit a filing stating whether or not the complaint in Case No. G-0109-17 should be scheduled for a prehearing conference and hearing or is withdrawn.
- 7. The State's appearance and answer is due in Case G-0109-17 within fifteen days after the Teamsters request for a pre-hearing conference and hearing in the event such a request is filed.
