Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate

Pursuant to the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A) and the results of a secret ballot election (see PELRB Decision No. 2024-207), it is hereby certified that the Londonderry Association of Allied Health Professionals/NEA-NH has been designated and selected as the exclusive representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances of the following bargaining unit:

Unit:

Speech Language Pathologist, Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Speech Assistants, Certified Occupational Therapists Assistants, and School Nurses.

The Londonderry School District shall negotiate with the Londonderry Association of Allied Health Professionals/NEA-NH as exclusive representative on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of the Londonderry Association of Allied Health Professionals/NEA-NH to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
