Order

On October 21, 2024, the Teamsters Local 633 filed a Petition for Certification – Challenge to Existing Representative requesting an election to resolve the question of representation of certain Concord School District employees currently represented by the United Professional Bus Drivers of Concord, UAW Local 2322 (UAW). See PELRB Decision No. 2015-086 (May 4, 2015). The composition of the bargaining unit is as follows:

Unit: Bus drivers, monitors, and spare bus drivers that are employed by the Concord School District.

Excluded: Supervisory: Persons exercising supervisory authority involving the significant exercise of discretion pursuant to RSA 273-A:8, II. Confidential: Persons whose duties imply a confidential relationship to the public employer pursuant to RSA 273-A:1, IX.

The petition was supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the October 22, 2024 PELRB Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. Neither the UAW nor the District objected to this petition. No other exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case.

The Teamsters' request for an election to resolve the question of representation is granted. Accordingly, the PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the existing bargaining unit, if any. "Teamsters Local 633", "United Professional Bus Drivers of Concord, UAW Local 2322", and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall be issued, and a pre-election conference shall be conducted in accordance with Admin. R. Pub 303.02.

So ordered.
