

MOTION FOR REVIEW OF DECISION OF HEARING OFFICER

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on March 10, 1994, took the following actions:

1. It reviewed the Union's request for PELRB review of the decision of the hearing officer filed on February 7, 1994 and the County's objection thereto filed on February 11, 1994.
2. It examined the County's unfair labor practice charge filed on June 4, 1993 and the Union's answer filed on June 15, 1993. (Decision No 93-163)
3. It reviewed the decision (Decision No. 93-163) of the hearing officer in this matter dated December 29, 1993.
4. Pursuant to RSA 273-A:6, VIII it AFFIRMED the findings and conclusions of the hearing officer, thus DENYING any further relief under the pending Motion for Review.
