1. It reviewed the City's Motion to Stay Arbitration Proceedings dated January 15, 1992, and the Union's objection to Motion to Stay Arbitration dated January 29, 1992.
2. It DENIED the City's Motion to Stay Arbitration Proceedings.
3. It postponed the hearing set for February 13, 1992 relating to the City's underlying unfair labor practice complaint (Case No. F-0104:25) until the results of the foregoing arbitration are known and one or both of the parties hereto petitions for that case to be reactivated for hearing on the Board's docket of cases.
