PELRB Case No. T-0285:3 DECISION NO. 85-72 & 85-84 TIMBERLANE TEACHERS ASSOCIATION v. TIMBERLANE REGIONAL SCHOOL BOARD

Complaint filed on behalf of four teachers who sought to recover sick leave benefits while on maternity leave under provisions of the existing collective bargaining agreement.

After hearing, PELRB ruled that the employees were entitled to use their accumulated sick leave while on unpaid maternity leave and found the denial of such leave by the School Board a breach of the collective bargaining agreement and violation of RSA 273-A:5, I(h); and, ordered the School Board to compensate the four teachers for the periods of disability in question regardless of leave status.
