BOARD OF MANAGERS MEETING MINUTES JUNE 17, 2024

*APPROVAL OF MINUTES – May 20, 2024:

The Minutes of the Board of Managers Meeting from May 20, 2024, were reviewed and discussed. Motion was made by Raymond Goulet, Jr., seconded by Robert Blais, to accept the minutes. Minutes were accepted by the Board. There were no changes. Motion carried unanimously. The minutes will be placed on file.

*COMMUNICATIONS:

NHVH New Addition – Commandant MacKay reported the VA is asking for a new application for our approved project because we are changing it from the third floor to the first floor.

Commandant MacKay reported that we have 0 residents and 0 staff who tested positive for COVID. We continue to enact best practices to keep our veterans and staff healthy.

Commandant MacKay reported that we had a wonderful Flag Day Ceremony on Friday, June 14, 2024. We recorded a "Good Morning New Hampshire" video and Sarah Stanley submitted it to WMUR. The station let us know it will be aired on Channel 9 on Wednesday morning, June 19, 2024.

NHVH will be holding a **Blood Drive** on Monday, June 24, 2024, from 11:00-4:00 in the NHVH Town Hall. *All are welcome to come and join in this life-saving event*.

*CENSUS UPDATE:

Census/Admissions – As of June 17, 2024, we have 123 veterans in the Home: 112 men and 11 women.

Our current wait list is as follows:

*BUDGET UPDATE:

Jen Doig reviewed the FY24 Financial Summaries of the New Hampshire Veterans Home as of April 30, 2024 (Appendix C) with the Board.

• Jen will send out a breakdown of the Exhibit "C" report to the Board for review.

Commandant MacKay, Brian Baker and Jen Doig are working on the Governors Capital Budget presentation. They will present this to the Governor on Wednesday, June 19, 2024.

• Commandant MacKay will send the Board the presentation once complete.

*CAPITAL PROJECTS REPORT:

Commandant MacKay and Brian Baker provided an update on the New Hampshire Veterans Home's capital projects and operations highlights:

- **Paving Project** We received final approval from the Governor & Council on Wednesday June 12, 2024. Triple Construction won the bid for the job. Brian awaits a start date from them for this project.
- Eversource Lighting Project The project is approximately 80% complete. Eversource provided a grant to update all NHVH lighting fixtures with LED equipment. This project is expected to provide us a minimum savings of \$170,000 annually in our utility costs!
- **Pond Paving Project** CK Landmark is anticipated to start the project in the next two weeks. Brian spoke with CK Landmark today and they are also gifting us the site work for the concrete pads for the Gazabos at the pond.
- Tarr North Tub Room Project CK Landmark is anticipated to start the project in the next two weeks. This will repair a broken drain line in the tub room.
- NHVH Air Handlers for the LEDU / Tarr East Wings The motors have been ordered. RTH has an anticipated completion date of July 2024. We are currently using the heat pumps to assist to keep things cool. Temperatures are being monitored 3 times a day on the units.
- **Flagpole Project** The flag poles have been ordered.
